The Daffodil Club runs from Easterhouse Parish Church from Monday to Fridays. The club has been running for 30 years and some of our members attend it. It provides services which include a hot meal, physiotherapy, chiropody, and a hairdresser together with friendship for the Elderly in our community and is a lifeline for many.

The running of the club by 2 co-ordinators is solely charity funded by donation or grants from organisations and many volunteers. The Club only has enough money left in reserve to continue operating till August. A widespread drop in funding to charities across Scotland, married with rising running costs, has combined to push it to the brink.
