Chocolate Tubs Recycling

Tub2Pub is a recycling campaign by the UK pub chain Greene King to raise money for Macmillan Cancer Support and to recycle plastics. The 2025 campaign raised £10,916 from over 240,000 tubs.

If you have any Confectionery, biscuit or cracker tubs — e.g. Heroes, Celebrations, Jacob's Crackers, etc. - these will be collected to support the campaign. Please bring your clean and empty tubs and lids and leave them at the collection point at the front of the church. They will be delivered to a Greene King pub in early February 2026 — so no need to rush eating all those chocolates, biscuits and crackers!

The tubs will then be collected and taken to a plastic reprocessing centre, shredded and sold on to plastic manufacturers to use in place of virgin plastics, so as well as raising funds for Macmillan Cancer Support, you will also be doing your bit to save the planet.

Boys' Brigade - Empty Cans

The Boys' Brigade are fundraising by collecting empty drinks cans. Please bring along any empty washed cans.
